



10km optical module maximum transmission distance

Preview

In 10G SFP+ modules, "LR" stands for Long Reach and specifically refers to a standardized transmission distance of up to 10km over single-mode fiber. It follows the SFP+ Multi-Source Agreement (MSA) and is widely used to build stable medium-distance 10G links between switches, routers, and servers. Single-fiber bidirectional (BIDI) optical modules must be used in pairs. It utilizes four EML lasers with CWDM wavelengths (5nm wavelength spacing, requiring a TEC cooler to control temperature) and achieves a single-wave rate of 106.25Gbps based on PAM4 modulation. The fiber optic length, connector quality, cleanliness, and proper handling often determine whether a connection is stable or problematic.

10G SFP+ single-mode optical transceiver with duplex LC connector, 1310nm wavelength, and up to 10km transmission distance for enterprise and ISP fiber networks.

The conservative design constraints we used to use was 1,000m for MM fiber and 60km for SM fiber as a max. The laser's ability to transmit is

If the SFP-10G-ER-1310 is connected to a 10Gbase-ER standard optical module (1550nm, 10GE, 40km), the maximum transmission distance is only 20km due to different specifications such as wavelength

This product need to use in pair and match up with fiber converter and optical Ethernet switch with SFP slot, it can be used in Ethernet, telecom and optical

The maximum transmission distance for multi-mode is 2km, and single-mode can transmit up to 40km. Under 1310nm wavelength, 100Mbps, 1Gbps, 10Gbps,
