No. The typical Cisco switch is ready to go out-of-the-box. However, you might want to change some parameters to customize its operations.

Setting up an access switch involves connecting to the device, configuring basic parameters, securing access, creating VLANs, and assigning ports.

Step 1: Connect to the Switch

Use a console cable to connect your computer to the switch. Launch a terminal emulator like PuTTY, select the Serial connection type, specify the COM port, and set the baud rate (commonly 115200 for Cisco 300/500 series) to access the CLI .

Step 2: Enter Privileged EXEC Mode

At the prompt, type enable to enter Privileged EXEC mode (Switch#). This mode allows you to execute configuration commands .

Step 3: Set Hostname

Assign a unique hostname to identify the switch in the network:

```
Switch(config)# hostname AccessSwitch1
```

This helps in managing multiple switches .

Step 4: Configure Passwords

Set a strong enable secret password for Privileged EXEC mode:

```
AccessSwitch1(config)# enable secret YourStrongPassword
```

Also, secure console and VTY (Telnet/SSH) access:



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```
AccessSwitch1(config)# line console 0AccessSwitch1(config-line)# password  
ConsolePassAccessSwitch1(config-line)# loginAccessSwitch1(config)# line vty 0  
4AccessSwitch1(config-line)# password VTYPassAccessSwitch1(config-line)# login  
For enhanced security, consider using an external AAA server .
```

Step 5: Configure VLANs

Create VLANs to segment network traffic:

```
AccessSwitch1(config)# vlan 10AccessSwitch1(config-vlan)# name SalesAccessSwitch1(config)# vlan  
20AccessSwitch1(config-vlan)# name Marketing  
Verify VLANs with show vlan brief .
```

Step 6: Assign Ports to VLANs

Configure access ports to belong to specific VLANs:

```
AccessSwitch1(config)# interface gigabitEthernet 0/1AccessSwitch1(config-if)# switchport mode  
accessAccessSwitch1(config-if)# switchport access vlan 10AccessSwitch1(config-if)# exit  
Repeat for other ports as needed .
```

Step 7: Configure Trunk Ports (Optional)

If connecting to another switch or router, configure trunk ports to carry multiple VLANs:

```
AccessSwitch1(config)# interface gigabitEthernet 0/24AccessSwitch1(config-if)# switchport mode  
trunkAccessSwitch1(config-if)# switchport trunk allowed vlan 10,20
```

Step 8: Enable Spanning Tree Protocol (STP)

STP prevents loops in the network:

```
AccessSwitch1(config)# spanning-tree mode rapid-pvst  
This is recommended for multi-switch environments .
```

Step 9: Save Configuration

Save your configuration to prevent loss after a reboot:

```
AccessSwitch1# write memory  
or
```



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```
AccessSwitch1# copy running-config startup-config
```

Step 10: Verify Configuration

Check VLANs, port assignments, and connectivity:

```
AccessSwitch1# show vlan briefAccessSwitch1# show running-configAccessSwitch1# ping
```

This ensures the switch is properly configured and operational . Following these steps will provide a secure, functional access switch setup ready for deployment in your network.
