- o **Splice Plates:** Flat metal plates with pre-drilled holes are bolted to the ends of two tray sections to join them in a straight line. This method provides strong, rigid connections suitable for heavy loads ().
- o **Bolted Connections:** Directly bolting tray ends together ensures a secure and permanent join. This method is reliable for both perforated and solid-bottom trays ().
- o **Quick Connect Systems:** These allow faster installation and flexibility for future modifications. They are ideal for projects requiring frequent changes or additions ().
- o **Clamps and Fish Plates:** Clamps can hold trays together without drilling, while fish plates provide additional support for alignment and load distribution ().
- o **Welding:** Used in specialized applications where a permanent, high-strength connection is required, though less common in standard installations ().

- o Align trays properly before connecting to avoid misalignment and stress on cables ().
- o Check load ratings and ensure supports are spaced according to tray type and cable weight ().
- o Re-drill perforations if unperforated trays are cut to maintain proper connection points ().
- o Use covers and turn buckles where required to protect cables and maintain system integrity (). By following these practices, cable tray connections will be safe, stable, and compliant, ensuring long-term reliability and ease of maintenance.
