

Article Overview

Belize does not publicly list a specific Level 3 Distribution Box standard, but such equipment is regulated under the Belize Bureau of Standards using regional and international electrical standards.

Regulatory Framework

In Belize, the Belize Bureau of Standards (BBS) is the national authority responsible for developing, promoting, and enforcing standards for goods, services, and processes, including electrical equipment . The BBS operates under the Standards Act of 1992 (Revised 2000) and aligns national standards with CARICOM regional standards and international standards such as ASTM and Underwriters Laboratories (UL) . This ensures that electrical distribution equipment meets safety, performance, and quality requirements.

Electrical Distribution Box Standards

While a specific "Level 3 Distribution Box" standard is not listed in the publicly available BBS catalogue, electrical distribution boxes in Belize are generally expected to comply with:

- o Safety and performance standards based on international norms (e.g., IEC, UL, or ASTM standards for low- and medium-voltage distribution equipment).
- o Labeling and marking requirements as mandated by BBS, including manufacturer details, voltage rating, and safety warnings .
- o Conformity assessment: Imported or locally manufactured distribution boxes must provide test reports or certificates of conformity to demonstrate compliance with applicable standards .

Compliance and Certification

To legally trade or install electrical distribution boxes in Belize:

- o Submit technical documentation to BBS for assessment, including product specifications, test reports, and certification from recognized laboratories.
- o Ensure labeling meets BBS requirements, including English-language instructions, voltage ratings, and safety information .
- o Follow regional or international standards referenced by BBS, which may include UL 67 (for panelboards) or IEC 61439 (for low-voltage switchgear and controlgear assemblies), depending on the type of distribution box.
