

Cabinet installed under the distribution box

A cabinet installed under a distribution box should be securely mounted, maintain proper clearances, and comply with electrical safety standards to ensure safe and organized power distribution.

Placement and Clearance

When installing a cabinet beneath a distribution box, ensure the area is dry, accessible, and well-ventilated. Maintain sufficient clearance above and around the distribution box for safe operation, inspection, and maintenance. Mounting Methods

- o Surface-Mounted Cabinets: Use metal expansion bolts or galvanized bolts to secure the cabinet to the wall. Drill vertical holes matching the bolt sleeves and ensure the cabinet is level.
- o Recessed Cabinets: Align the cabinet with pre-reserved wall voids, fix it in place, and fill edges with cement mortar. Ensure the surface is flat and gaps are evenly filled to prevent plaster from covering the panel.
- o Anti-Loosening Measures: All bolts and fasteners should include anti-loosening components, and if fire protection is required, inlets and outlets should be fire-sealed.

Material and Safety Considerations

Cabinets can be made of steel, aluminum, or high-quality plastics like polycarbonate. Ensure the material is durable, corrosion-resistant, and suitable for the environment (indoor or outdoor) with appropriate IP/NEMA ratings. Grounding is essential: connect the cabinet to the PE bar to prevent electrical hazards.

Wiring and Electrical Compliance

- o Use insulated copper wires with a minimum cross-section of 2.5 mm² for current circuits and 1.5 mm² for other circuits.
- o Bundle secondary circuits separately by voltage level, AC/DC lines, and control lines, labeling each for easy identification.
- o Include protective devices such as breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit.
- o Perform insulation resistance testing after installation to verify safety between phases, neutral, and ground.

Maintenance and Accessibility

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Label all circuits and components clearly. Ensure the cabinet allows easy access for future upgrades, inspections, and maintenance. Modular designs can simplify future expansions or replacements. By following these guidelines, a cabinet installed under a distribution box will provide safe, organized, and compliant electrical management while maintaining accessibility and long-term reliability.
