Overview

Cable entry solutions are designed to allow electrical cables to pass safely into distribution boxes, junction boxes, or control panels while maintaining dust- and water-tight seals and providing mechanical strain relief. They are essential for protecting both the cables and the internal components of the enclosure from bending, kinking, or environmental damage.

Types of Cable Entry Systems

- o **Cable Glands** Cable glands are widely used for standard and industrial applications. They consist of a cap nut, sealing insert, and socket, which secure the cable to the enclosure wall. They provide protection against mechanical stress and environmental influences such as dust and moisture. Cable glands are available in plastic, brass, or stainless steel, and can include EMC inserts or ATEX-certified versions for hazardous areas.
- o **Grommet-Based Entry Frames** Systems like KT or QT grommet-based frames allow preterminated or large-diameter cables to be routed at 90° angles to the enclosure wall. They are available in single or double row versions and can accommodate cables up to 75 mm in diameter. These frames often feature tool-free assembly and flat gaskets to ensure a clean seal.
- o **Split Cable Entry Frames** Split frames are suitable for flat cables or prefabricated round cables, allowing easy installation without disconnecting connectors. They are ideal for high-density cable routing and can be closed with cover plugs at unused openings.
- o **Flameproof or Ex d Cable Entries** For hazardous environments, flameproof cable entries allow cables to enter Ex d enclosures safely. They use a threaded metal sleeve to anchor and encapsulate the cable, ensuring compliance with DIN EN 60079 standards. These entries can be customized for cable length and core connections.

- o **Sealing and IP/NEMA Ratings:** Ensure the system maintains ingress protection against dust and water.
- o **Strain Relief:** Protects cables from bending, pulling, or kinking, extending cable life.

- o **Installation Ease:** Tool-free or snap-in systems reduce installation time and complexity.
