

## Article Overview

Cable tray elbow fittings are available in standard angles and sizes to connect straight tray sections, with dimensions defined by width, height, and bend radius for proper cable routing.

## Types of Elbow Fittings

Cable tray elbow fittings are used to change the direction of cable runs and are typically classified as:

- o Horizontal Elbows: Change direction in the horizontal plane (90° or 45° bends).
- o Vertical Elbows: Change direction in the vertical plane, either inside (concave) or outside (convex) bends.
- o Adjustable Elbows: Allow variable angles for custom routing. These fittings are designed to match the width and height of the straight tray sections to maintain cable support and NEC fill compliance .

## Standard Dimensions

Cable tray elbow dimensions are standardized to ensure compatibility with straight sections:

- o Width (W): Nominal inside usable width, commonly ranging from 50 mm to 600 mm for industrial and commercial applications. The outside width is slightly larger due to side rail thickness .
- o Height (H): Side rail height or tray depth, typically 50 mm, 70 mm, 100 mm, or 120 mm, controlling vertical stacking capacity and heat dissipation .
- o Bend Radius: For smooth cable routing, elbows often have a radius equal to 1-2 times the tray width, depending on cable type and bend angle .
- o Material Thickness: Usually 1.2-2.0 mm for steel trays, with options for hot-dip galvanized, powder-coated, or bare steel .

## Diagram Representation

Elbow fittings are usually illustrated in technical catalogs as follows:

- o Top View: Shows the horizontal bend and alignment with straight tray sections.
- o Side View: Shows vertical bends and height alignment.
- o Isometric View: Provides a 3D perspective for installation planning. These diagrams indicate connection points, bolt hole locations, and bend angles, ensuring proper assembly with straight tray sections .
