Standard cable tray widths per IEC 61537 and manufacturers' ranges are typically 50, 75, 100, 150, 200, 225, 300, 400, 450, 500, 600, 750, 900, and 1000mm. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements --width, depth, length, and material thickness--that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability. International projects are most often made in widths of between 50mm and 900mm and depths of between 50mm and 150mm. The majority of the sections have a length of 3 meters, as this is easy to transport and can be compactly. Selecting the right cable tray size is critical for electrical safety, system efficiency, and cost control. Cable tray fill is the proportion of usable cross-sectional area inside a cable tray occupied by installed cables. NEC Article 392 limits fill ratios based on cable type and arrangement -- single-layer or stacked -- to ensure adequate ventilation, maintain current-carrying capacity, and provide space. Standard cable tray systems are manufactured in a range of widths, depths, and lengths designed to accommodate various installation scenarios, from compact commercial buildings to expansive industrial facilities.
