Types of Cable Trays for Long Spans

- o Support span is the distance between supports; for long-span trays, this can exceed 20 feet and reach up to 40 feet for outdoor or bridge crossings .
- o Tray strength must be designed according to the selected support span, as deflection increases with longer spans .
- o Splice plates connect tray sections and should generally be placed only once between supports to maintain structural integrity .
- o Material selection: Aluminum is preferred for long spans due to its high strength-to-weight ratio and corrosion resistance, while steel may be used for heavier loads .

Installation Best Practices

- o Ensure the tray length matches or exceeds the support span to control splice locations and reduce stress points .
- o Use suspended supports, wall brackets, or center suspensions to attach trays to the bridge structure securely .
- o Consider environmental factors such as wind, snow, and temperature changes, which can affect tray deflection and expansion .
- o For outdoor installations, corrosion-resistant coatings or materials are recommended to extend service life .
