

Article Overview

Cables for a distribution box are selected based on the type of load, voltage, and current rating, and they connect the main supply to protective devices and then to individual circuits.

Types of Cables

- o **Power Cables:** These carry the main electrical supply into the distribution box and from the box to various loads. For single-phase domestic systems, typical cables are 2-core or 3-core insulated copper cables rated for 230V AC, while three-phase industrial systems use 3-core or 4-core cables rated for 400V AC or higher .
- o **Control and Signal Cables:** In modular or decentralized distribution boxes, such as FieldPower(R) systems, signal and sensor cables are used for communication between devices. These can range from 0.5 mm² to 10 mm² depending on current requirements .
- o **Specialty Cables:** For outdoor or harsh environments, armored or weather-resistant cables are used to ensure durability, impact resistance, and corrosion protection .

Connection and Wiring

- o **Main Input:** The main supply cable connects to the main MCB or main switch. In single-phase systems, a double-pole MCB is commonly used, while in three-phase systems, a three-pole MCB or Powerlock connectors may be used for higher amperages .
- o **Branch Circuits:** Output cables from the distribution box connect to individual MCBs or RCCBs, which then feed the respective loads. Single-pole MCBs are used for standard loads, and double-pole MCBs may be used for special or high-power loads .
- o **Signal and Data Connections:** In modular distribution boxes, pluggable insulation displacement connections allow easy and secure attachment of signal or actuator cables .

Safety and Standards

- o Ensure cables are rated for the current and voltage of the system to prevent overheating or fire hazards .
- o Use RCCBs or MCBs to protect circuits from overcurrent or short circuits .
- o For industrial or outdoor setups, select cables and boxes with IP44 to IP67 ratings for protection against dust and water ingress .
- o Follow local electrical codes and standards, such as IEC 61439 for industrial distribution boxes .
