

Can Huawei switches be directly plugged into fiber optic cables

Article Overview

Huawei switches can be connected to fiber optic cables using compatible optical modules and appropriate fiber types, such as single-mode or multimode, through SFP or SFP+ ports.

Fiber Connection Overview

Huawei switches, including S series models like S5700 and S5720, support fiber optic connections via SFP (1 Gbps) or SFP+ (10 Gbps) ports. These ports require optical modules that match the fiber type and transmission distance. Multimode modules are suitable for short distances (typically within a few hundred meters) using 850 nm wavelength, while single-mode modules are used for long-distance links (kilometers) with 1310 nm or 1550 nm wavelength .

Required Components

- o Optical Modules: Inserted into the switch's SFP/SFP+ slots. Ensure the module's speed matches the port (e.g., do not use a 10G module on a 1G port) and that the module type matches the fiber (single-mode or multimode), .
- o Fiber Patch Cords or Jumpers: Connect the optical module to another device or fiber terminal. The fiber type must match the module type, and the length should suit the cabling distance .
- o Active Optical Cables (AOCs): For short-distance connections, AOCs can replace separate optical modules and fibers, providing a fixed-length solution with integrated connectors .

Connection Procedure

- o Prepare the fibers: Remove dust caps, clean connectors, and label both ends to match port numbers .
- o Insert the optical module: Align the module with the SFP/SFP+ slot and insert until it clicks.
- o Connect the fiber: Align the fiber connector with the module's bore and insert until secure. Ensure the transmit (TX) and receive (RX) ends are correctly matched .
- o Verify connectivity: Use commands like `display transceiver interface xgigabitethernet 0/0/2 verbose` to check optical power and port status .
- o Arrange fibers: Maintain proper bend radius (≥ 40 mm) and bundle fibers neatly to avoid damage .

Safety and Best Practices

- o Never look directly into fiber ends or optical modules, as they emit laser radiation .
- o Keep fibers away from power cables and protect them with corrugated pipes if routed in cabinets .
- o Use ESD protection when handling modules and fibers to prevent damage .
