Pulling Tension and Lubrication: Use a pulling grip attached to the cable's strength member, not the jacket, and apply a fiber-rated lubricant to reduce friction. Monitor pulling tension with a dynamometer to avoid exceeding the manufacturer's maximum tension, which typically ranges from 270 to 600 lbs for standard fiber cables . 4. Innerduct Usage: For multiple cables or future expansion, installing innerducts inside the conduit can create separate channels, making subsequent cable pulls easier and reducing friction . 5. Pre-Installation Inspection: Inspect the conduit for sharp edges, debris, or moisture before pulling the cable. Use pull tape or rope to facilitate smooth installation .
