It performs signal conversion between the provider's electrical network and the fiber network and coordinates communication with multiple ONTs or Optical Network Units (ONUs). Functionally, an OLT is similar to a network switch, as each port can manage multiple customer endpoints through multiplexing and splitting, effectively directing traffic between the central office and connected ONTs . However, OLTs are designed for provider-level aggregation rather than direct device-to-device LAN switching.

Key Differences from Traditional Switches

While ONTs and OLTs can perform switching functions, they differ from standard Layer 2 or Layer 3 switches:

- o Layer of operation: ONTs typically operate at Layer 1 or Layer 2, handling signal conversion and basic frame forwarding, whereas traditional switches manage MAC addresses and sometimes IP routing for complex LANs .
- o Scope: ONTs switch traffic within a single premises, while OLTs manage traffic across multiple customer endpoints in a PON.
- o Intelligence: Traditional switches have more advanced features like VLANs, link aggregation, and QoS, which may be limited or absent in ONTs .
