

# Can an SC fiber optic patch cord connect to the internet

- o Use the correct polish type (PC, UPC, or APC) to minimize signal reflection and loss .
- o SC connectors are compatible with many internet service setups, including fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) and enterprise networks .
