Common fiber optic patch cords include SC, LC, FC, ST, MPO, MU, MT-RJ, and E2000 types, available in single-mode and multimode configurations.

Fiber Modes

- o Single-Mode (SM, OS1/OS2): Yellow jacket, small core (~9um), supports long-distance transmission with low attenuation, ideal for telecom and long-haul networks .
- o Multimode (MM, OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5): Larger core (50-62.5um), supports multiple light paths, suitable for short-distance, high-bandwidth applications like data centers and LANs. Jacket colors vary: OM1/OM2 = orange, OM3 = aqua, OM4 = violet, OM5 = lime green .

Connector Types

- o SC (Subscriber Connector): Square, snap-in, widely used in PON and enterprise networks .
- o LC (Lucent Connector): Small form factor, duplex, common in modern data centers, fits QSFP transceivers via LC breakouts .
- o FC (Ferrule Connector): Screw-on, used in high-vibration environments .
- o ST (Straight Tip): Bayonet mount, common in legacy networks .
- o MPO/MTP: Multi-fiber connectors for high-density applications, often used in backbone or data center interconnects .
- o MU, MT-RJ, E2000, DIN: Specialized connectors for specific network setups or high-performance requirements .

Cable Configurations

- o Simplex: Single fiber, one-way transmission .
- o Duplex: Two fibers, bidirectional communication, commonly used in data centers .
- o Indoor/Outdoor Jackets: PVC (basic indoor), Plenum (OFNP, fire-resistant), Riser (OFNR, vertical shafts), LSZH (low smoke, zero halogen, common in Europe and high-safety areas), .

Applications

- o Intra-rack connections: Server NIC to top-of-rack switch via LC duplex or MPO breakout .
- o Inter-rack connections: Horizontal patching between row distribution frames and spine switches .
- o Cross-connect frames: Structured patching in main distribution areas for colocation and enterprise IDF/MDF .
- o FTTH/building entry: Indoor-outdoor transition cables connecting outside plant to customer premise .
