Conventional Wiring of a Distribution Box

A standard distribution box (DB) distributes electrical power from the main supply to subcircuits safely. The wiring process typically involves:

- o Incoming Supply Connection: Phase and neutral lines from the energy meter are connected to the main isolator (DP MCB), which acts as the main switch for the system .
- o Protective Devices: From the isolator, phase lines are routed to an RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) or RCD to protect against leakage currents and electric shocks. Neutral lines are connected to a neutral busbar .
- o Subcircuit Distribution: Phase lines are connected in parallel to MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers) for each subcircuit, providing overcurrent protection. Neutral lines are connected to the neutral link .
- o Earthing: Proper grounding is essential for safety, connecting the earth busbar to all metallic parts and protective devices .

Wiring for Monitoring

To enable monitoring of a distribution box, additional steps are required:

- o Smart Sensors and Meters: Install current transformers (CTs) on each phase to measure current flow. Voltage sensors can be added to monitor voltage levels .
- o Microcontroller or IoT Module: Connect the sensors to a microcontroller or IoT-enabled module to collect real-time data on load, power consumption, and system performance .
- o Communication Interface: Use Wi-Fi, Ethernet, or RS485 protocols to transmit data to a monitoring dashboard or mobile app for remote tracking .
- o Automation and Alerts: Integrate overload protection, short-circuit detection, and automated alerts to notify users of abnormal conditions .

Best Practices

- o Cable Management: Keep wiring neat and organized using DIN rails, cable entry points, and proper insulation .
- o Compliance: Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC) and use certified components (UL/CE) for safety .
