Understanding the FTTH Setup

- o Quality of Service (QoS): Configure QoS to prioritize bandwidth for critical applications like video conferencing or gaming .

- o Splitter Placement: In multi-user setups, ensure optical splitters are optimally placed to minimize signal loss .
- o VLANs and Advanced Settings: For business networks, configure VLANs and traffic management to integrate with existing infrastructure .

- o Media Converters: If your router does not have a direct fiber port, use compatible media converters (e.g., SFP to RJ45) to connect fiber to Ethernet devices .
- o Network Cards and Switches: Ensure all network hardware supports the desired speeds (1G, 10G) for seamless data transmission .
