

Connecting the incoming power line to the distribution box

The incoming power line to a distribution box is connected via a main circuit breaker, with phase, neutral, and ground wires properly secured to their respective terminals, following color codes and safety standards.

Identify the Incoming Line

The incoming line is the main power supply entering the distribution box. It can be single-phase (typically 220V) or three-phase (380V) depending on your system. The incoming line usually passes through a main circuit breaker, air switch, or knife switch to allow safe disconnection and protection of the system .

Wire Configuration and Color Coding

A standard incoming line uses a five-wire system:

- o Three-phase lines (A, B, C): Red, yellow, and green (for three-phase systems)
- o Neutral line: Light blue
- o Ground line: Yellow with green stripes For single-phase loads, one phase line, one neutral, and one ground are used. For three-phase loads, all three phases plus neutral and ground are connected .

Connection Procedure

- o Turn off the main power supply before starting any work to ensure safety .
- o Secure the phase wires to the main circuit breaker or 3-pin/4-pin breaker. In a 4-pin breaker, the three-phase lines and neutral enter together, while the ground wire is connected to the grounding terminal block .
- o Connect the neutral wire to the neutral busbar.
- o Connect the ground wire to the grounding busbar. Proper grounding is essential for safety and to prevent electrical hazards .
- o Verify connections using a multimeter to ensure correct voltage and continuity before powering on the system .

Safety and Compliance

- o Ensure the distribution box is installed in a dry, accessible area with proper ventilation and at an appropriate height (~1.5m), .
- o Use correct wire gauge and breaker size according to the load.
- o Include protection devices like MCBs, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit .
- o Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use certified components.

- o Label all circuits for easy identification and future maintenance .
- o Consider modular designs for easier upgrades.
