Copper core optical cables are generally less expensive than fiber optic cables, with prices influenced by category, shielding, length, and installation requirements.

Estimated Pricing

Copper cables, commonly used for short-range data transmission in LANs, typically cost less than fiber optic cables, with prices varying based on category (Cat5e, Cat6, Cat6a), shielding (STP vs UTP), and environmental ratings (). While exact per-foot prices are not standardized, typical retail costs for copper network cables range from \$0.10 to \$1.50 per foot for bulk purchases, depending on quality and specifications. Pre-terminated or custom-length assemblies may cost more due to factory termination and connector type.

Factors Affecting Cost

- o Cable Category: Higher categories (Cat6a) support faster speeds and higher bandwidth, increasing cost compared to Cat5e or Cat6.
- o Shielding: Shielded twisted pair (STP) cables are more expensive than unshielded (UTP) due to additional materials and protection against interference.
- o Environmental Ratings: Outdoor-rated cables with UV, moisture, and temperature resistance, or plenum/LSZH-rated cables for indoor air-handling spaces, can cost 10-30% more than standard PVC-jacketed cables ().
- o Length and Bulk Purchase: Buying in reels or drums reduces per-foot cost for large projects, while short pre-cut lengths may be more expensive.
- o Installation Complexity: Labor, termination, and tools (crimpers, testers) add to the total cost, especially for field-terminated runs.

Comparison with Fiber Optic Cables

Copper cables are suitable for short-range applications up to 100 meters, supporting speeds up to 10 Gbps, whereas fiber optic cables are preferred for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications (). Fiber cables generally cost more per foot, ranging from \$0.09 to \$6 per foot depending on strand count and type ().

Practical Considerations

- o For LAN deployments, copper core optical cables are cost-effective and easier to terminate.
- o For data centers or high-density installations, pre-terminated copper assemblies may reduce labor costs despite higher upfront prices.
- o Outdoor or harsh environments require cables with protective jackets, which increases cost but ensures durability and compliance. In summary, the price of copper core optical cable depends on category, shielding,
