Cold aisle containment systems in Denmark data centers can be customized to specific depths, including 800mm, using modular and suspended solutions for optimal cooling efficiency.

## Cold Aisle Design Considerations

Cold aisle containment (CAC) is a widely used strategy to separate cold supply air from hot exhaust air, improving cooling efficiency and reducing energy consumption in high-density server environments . The depth of the cold aisle is a critical factor, as it determines airflow distribution and accessibility for maintenance. While typical cold aisle widths range from 800mm to 1200mm, the exact dimension can be tailored to the data center layout, rack size, and cooling requirements .

## Modular and Suspended Solutions

In Denmark, hyper-scale data centers have implemented modular suspended structural cold aisles to meet bespoke requirements . These systems:

- o Enclose the space between server racks to maintain a cold-air plenum.
- o Integrate electrical and mechanical services within the aisle without obstructing airflow.
- o Use off-site pre-fabrication and modular assembly to ensure quality, safety, and faster deployment.
- o Allow flexibility for future expansion or changes in rack configuration. This approach ensures that even a relatively narrow cold aisle, such as 800mm, can maintain effective cooling while supporting high-density racks and complex service integration .

## Energy Efficiency and Operational Benefits

Properly designed cold aisle containment:

- o Reduces hot and cold air mixing, preventing recirculation and bypass airflow.
- o Optimizes Power Usage Effectiveness (PUE) by lowering cooling energy demand.
- o Supports high-density deployments, including racks exceeding 10 kW per unit, without compromising inlet temperatures .

## Practical Recommendations

- o Survey and modeling: Use 2D/3D CAD or BIM to simulate airflow and confirm that 800mm depth provides sufficient clearance for maintenance and airflow.

- o Modular panels: Employ adjustable or modular panels to accommodate obstacles, varying rack heights, or future expansion.
- o Integration with services: Ensure electrical, fire suppression, and monitoring systems are compatible with the cold aisle containment design . In summary, an 800mm cold aisle depth is feasible in Denmark data centers when using modular, suspended containment systems that are carefully designed to optimize airflow, energy efficiency, and operational flexibility .
