- o Shelves: Solid, vented, sliding, or fixed shelves for non-rack-mountable devices.
- o Doors and Panels: Perforated or solid front/rear doors for airflow and security; side panels for dust protection.
- o Power Distribution Units (PDUs): Provide power to all rack-mounted devices.
- o Cable Management: Vertical and horizontal organizers to route and label cables efficiently.
- o Cooling Systems: Fans or dedicated cooling units to manage thermal loads .

Types of Racks

- o Open-Frame Racks: No doors or side panels, offering easy access and maximum airflow but less security. Ideal for test labs or network closets .
- o Enclosed Cabinets: Provide added security and environmental control, often with locking mechanisms.
- o Cages: Secure areas within a data center that house multiple racks or cabinets, offering an extra layer of security .
