

Dimensions of Eastern European Household Electrical Distribution Boxes

Module-Based Distribution Boxes

Household distribution boxes in Eastern Europe are usually modular, designed to hold standard DIN rail-mounted devices such as MCBs, RCDs, and MCCBs. Common module capacities include 4, 6, 8, 12, 18, 24, 36, and 54 modules. These boxes are often made from halogen-free ABS or polycarbonate, with a grey base (RAL 7035) and a transparent window for visibility of internal devices .

- o Single-row boxes typically use a TH35x7.5 mm DIN rail and have a compact frame.
- o Multi-row boxes allow for more modules and may include multiple DIN rails for flexible device arrangement .

Typical External Dimensions

While there is no universal standard, common wall-mounted enclosure sizes for residential use in Europe generally range as follows :

- o Small boxes (4-6 modules): approximately 200x200x120 mm
- o Medium boxes (12-24 modules): approximately 400-600 mm width x 300-400 mm height x 120-200 mm depth
- o Large boxes (36-54 modules): up to 800x600x300 mm Depth is particularly important to accommodate wiring and ensure compliance with wire-fill requirements. Surface-mounted boxes may have slightly greater depth to allow for cable entry and splicing .

Mounting and Installation

- o Wall-mounting: Most household boxes are designed for flush or surface mounting. Mounting centers often follow 60 mm spacing for compatibility with European modular devices .
- o Internal layout: Boxes include removable gland plates and adjustable studs for easy installation of incoming and outgoing devices .
- o IP Ratings: Many boxes are rated IP65 for dust and water protection, suitable for indoor and outdoor installations .
