

Disassembly of electrical distribution box machine

- o Conduits and Supports: Remove all straps, supports, bolts, screws, and ground rods. Plug openings in junction boxes according to code requirements .

- o Lifting tools for heavy components
- o Labeling materials (tags, color codes)

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o Voltage testers and grounding equipment

Packaging and Transport

Once disassembled, package components securely to prevent damage during transport. Use custom crates, shrink wrap, or cushioning for delicate parts. Heavy components may require rigging or lifting equipment for safe handling .
