Unlike a meter box, which primarily houses the electricity meter for billing and monitoring, a distribution box focuses on power management and circuit protection .

Types and Configurations

Distribution boxes can be modular or decentralized, allowing flexible installation in various environments, including industrial, commercial, and residential settings . They are available in multiple sizes and configurations, with options for pluggable connections, busbar systems, and modular enclosures to accommodate different numbers of circuits and spatial constraints . Some boxes are designed for high protection classes (up to IP67), ensuring resistance to dust, water, and harsh environmental conditions .

- o Flexible combination: Modular designs allow adaptation to spatial conditions and specific electrical requirements .

- o Safety and accessibility: Flush-mounted or surface-mounted options with secure locking systems prevent unauthorized access while allowing routine maintenance .

They manage power flow to lighting, appliances, machinery, and specialized equipment, ensuring safe and reliable operation .
