Distribution Box

A distribution box, also called a distribution board or panel, is the central unit in an electrical system that receives incoming power and divides it into multiple circuits. It houses protective devices such as circuit breakers, fuses, and residual current devices (RCDs) to prevent overloads, short circuits, and earth faults, ensuring both equipment and human safety . Distribution boxes are typically larger and designed for higher voltages and currents (220V-690V, tens to hundreds of amps) and are commonly used in residential, commercial, and industrial settings . They allow individual circuit control, enabling maintenance or isolation of one section without disrupting the entire system .

Junction Box

A junction box is primarily an enclosure for joining, branching, or terminating electrical wires. Unlike distribution boxes, it does not contain circuit breakers or fuses and is not used to control or distribute power . Its main purpose is to protect wire connections from dust, moisture, and accidental contact, ensuring reliable electrical continuity . Junction boxes are generally smaller, simpler, and designed for lower voltages (12V-240V depending on the application) and are widely used in residential wiring, lighting circuits, CCTV, communication systems, and solar panel installations . They also simplify troubleshooting and system expansion by providing accessible connection points .
