

Does an optical splitter cost money

Optical splitter prices vary widely, from around \$10-\$30 for consumer audio splitters to \$5-\$15 per unit for professional fiber optic splitters, depending on type, configuration, and volume.

Consumer Audio Optical Splitters

For home audio or gaming setups, optical splitters that split one digital audio signal into two outputs typically cost \$10 to \$30. Prices depend on build quality, connector type, and supported audio formats. High-quality splitters may feature aluminum construction, gold-plated connectors, and support for Dolby Digital or DTS-HD sound formats . These are widely available on platforms like Amazon and eBay .

Professional Fiber Optic Splitters

For fiber optic networks (FTTH, PON, GPON, XGS-PON), the price of a 1x4 PLC splitter depends on several factors: connector type, fiber grade, pigtail length, testing, and certification. Standard configurations (SC/APC, G.657.A2 fiber, 1.0 m pigtail) typically cost \$5-\$15 per unit. Additional features can increase the price slightly: LC/UPC connectors add ~\$0.30/unit, FC/APC adds ~\$0.50/unit, and Telcordia certification adds ~\$0.30/unit . FBT splitters are cheaper by 20-30% but have higher failure rates in outdoor deployments .

Factors Affecting Price

- o Connector Type: SC/APC, SC/UPC, LC/UPC, FC/APC
- o Fiber Type: Standard G.652.D vs. bend-insensitive G.657.A2
- o Pigtail Length: Custom lengths can increase cost by 5-10%
- o Testing Level: Per-unit IL/RL test reports increase reliability but slightly raise cost
- o Certification: Compliance with Telcordia or other standards may add to price
