- o IP Address Assignment: Using DHCP, the router assigns unique local IP addresses to each connected device .
- o Traffic Management: It directs incoming and outgoing data to the correct devices efficiently .
- o Wireless Connectivity: Most modern routers provide Wi-Fi, enabling wireless devices to connect to the network . Without a router, only one device could typically use the internet at a time, and internal network communication would be limited.

How They Work Together

- o ONT to Router: An Ethernet cable connects the ONT to the router, which then distributes the internet connection to all devices in the home or office .
