

Fiber optic cable can t be used with a router

- o Configure Router: Most routers automatically detect the connection, but you may need to enter ISP-provided settings in the router's configuration page .
- o Test the Connection: Verify internet access and performance using network testing tools or by checking connectivity on connected devices .

Considerations

- o Router Upgrade: If your current router does not support fiber directly, you can still use it with an ONT. For higher speeds, consider upgrading to a router that supports gigabit Ethernet or Wi-Fi 6 .
- o Cable Management: Fiber cables are delicate; avoid bending beyond the minimum bend radius and ensure connectors are properly aligned and locked .
- o Professional Installation: For optimal performance and reliability, professional installation of fiber and ONT devices is recommended, especially in complex network setups .
