

Fiber optic cable connected network not working

Check Physical Connections

Ensure the fiber cable is free from bends, cuts, or contamination. Inspect connectors for dust or oil and clean them with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol. Reseat the cable firmly in both ports to confirm proper alignment, as loose or misaligned connectors can prevent network traffic despite link lights being active .

Test Hardware Components

Swap SFP transceivers with known-good units to rule out faulty modules. Restart switches, routers, or media converters to clear temporary glitches. If using unmanaged or "dumb" switches, verify that the link lights are on, but remember these switches may not provide detailed diagnostics .

Verify Network Configuration

Check for IP conflicts, DHCP issues, or incorrect subnet settings. Assign a static IP in the correct range to a device connected to the switch and attempt to ping the default gateway. If the ping fails, the issue may be with the router or switch configuration rather than the fiber itself .

Use Diagnostic Tools

For persistent problems, use an OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) or optical power meter to measure signal strength and locate breaks or attenuation points. Values outside the normal range (-15dBm to -30dBm) indicate potential fiber issues . Network monitoring tools like Wireshark or PRTG can help identify traffic bottlenecks or misconfigurations.

Consider Environmental and Power Factors

Ensure that POE injectors or power supplies are functioning correctly, as faulty injectors can block network traffic even when the fiber link is active . Environmental factors like moisture or temperature extremes can also affect signal integrity.
