- o Low insertion loss - should not exceed 0.75
- o Typical insertion repeatability, the difference in insertion loss between one plugging and another, is 0.2 dB.
- o On all connectors, cleaning the ceramic ferrule before each connection helps prevent scratches and extends the connector life substantially.
- o Connectors on polarization-maintaining fiber are sometimes.
