- o Fiber Drop: A fiber cable is run from a neighborhood terminal (pole or underground box) to your home.
- o Network Interface Device (NID): A small box outside your home houses the fiber and connects it to the ONT.
- o ONT Setup: The ONT converts light signals into electrical data for your network.
- o Router Connection and Testing: The ONT is linked to your router, and the technician tests the connection to ensure full speed and reliability. For larger homes, mesh Wi-Fi systems may be added for better coverage. Professional installation is usually required, though some ISPs offer combo units or limited self-install options . Installation for a standard home typically takes 2-6 hours .
