Types of Splitters

There are two main types of splitters used in FTTH networks:

- o PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) Splitters: Compact, uniform, and ideal for large split ratios like 1x16 or 1x32. They provide consistent signal distribution and are widely used in GPON, EPON, and XGS-PON networks .
- o FBT (Fused Biconical Taper) Splitters: Lower-cost option, better suited for small split ratios like 1x2 or 1x4. They are less uniform than PLC but sufficient for small-scale home deployments .

Split Ratios

The split ratio determines how many outputs a single fiber can serve. Common ratios for home access include:

- o 1x2 or 1x4: Small-scale sharing, suitable for a few homes or devices.
- o 1x8, 1x16, 1x32: Larger deployments, allowing one fiber to serve multiple residences efficiently .

Installation and Housing

Splitters are often installed in fiber distribution boxes (FDBs) or fiber access terminals (FATs), which protect the fiber connections and provide patching interfaces to ONUs/ONTs in homes . These boxes can be wall-mounted, pole-mounted, or placed indoors, and they typically include splice trays and adapters for SC, LC, or FC connectors .

When selecting a splitter for home access, consider:

- o Network type: Ensure compatibility with GPON, XGS-PON, or EPON.
- o Split ratio: Match the number of homes or devices you need to serve.
- o Connector type: SC/APC is common, but LC or FC may be required depending on your ONT/ONU.
- o Environment: Outdoor-rated boxes for weather protection if installed outside .
