 - o Connect the earth wire to the earth bus bar .

 - o Connect the output of the main MCB to the input of the RCCB.
 - o Connect the output of the RCCB to the single-pole MCBs for individual circuits .
- o Wire Individual Circuits:
 - o Connect the live wire from each MCB to the corresponding circuit.
 - o Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar.
 - o Connect the earth wire to the earth bus bar.
 - o Label each MCB to indicate the circuit it controls (e.g., kitchen, lighting, AC), .
