Electrical distribution boxes in Honduras are regulated under national standards coordinated by the Organismo Hondureño de Normalización (OHN), often referencing international standards such as IEC, ISO, and ASTM.

Regulatory Framework

In Honduras, the National Standards Body (OHN), operating under the National Quality System and the Ministry of Economic Development, is responsible for formulating, approving, and disseminating standards, including those for electrical equipment like distribution boxes (Organismo Hondureño de Normalización/OHN). OHN ensures that standards facilitate trade, improve safety, and provide technical guidance for industrial and residential electrical installations.

Applicable Standards

Honduran electrical distribution boxes typically follow internationally recognized standards:

- o IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission): Covers electrical enclosures, protection ratings (IP codes), and safety requirements for low-voltage distribution boxes.
- o ISO (International Organization for Standardization): Provides quality management and material standards relevant to manufacturing and installation.
- o ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials): Specifies material durability, fire resistance, and mechanical properties for electrical enclosures. These standards are often voluntary but widely adopted in practice, especially for imported equipment or projects requiring compliance with international safety norms.

Technical and Safety Considerations

Electrical distribution boxes in Honduras must meet the following general requirements:

- o Protection against electrical shock: Proper insulation, grounding, and separation of live components.
- o Ingress protection (IP rating): Boxes must resist dust and water according to IEC 60529 standards.
- o Material durability: Use of corrosion-resistant metals or high-quality plastics suitable for tropical climates.
- o Labeling and identification: Clear marking of circuits, voltage ratings, and safety warnings.
- o Compliance with local electrical codes: Installation must follow the Honduran electrical code, which aligns with international low-voltage safety practices.

Certification and Conformity

Manufacturers and importers may need to demonstrate conformity assessment through testing or certification, often coordinated by OHN or the Organismo Hondureno de Acreditacion (OHA) . This ensures that distribution boxes meet safety, performance, and quality standards before being installed in residential, commercial, or industrial settings.

- o For residential and commercial projects, using OHN-compliant or IEC-certified distribution boxes is recommended to ensure safety and regulatory acceptance.
- o For industrial or high-demand applications, adherence to IEC and ASTM standards ensures durability and protection against environmental factors.
- o Importers should verify that products meet OHN-recognized standards and obtain necessary documentation for customs and regulatory compliance. In summary, while Honduras does not have a unique national standard exclusively for electrical distribution boxes, compliance is achieved through OHN oversight and adoption of IEC, ISO, and ASTM standards, ensuring safety, quality, and compatibility with local electrical infrastructure .
