



How to access the internet in Vietnam without fiber optic cables

You can access the internet in Vietnam without fiber by using mobile 4G/5G networks, eSIMs, SIM cards, pocket Wi-Fi, or satellite services like Starlink.

Mobile Networks

Vietnam has near-universal 4G LTE coverage, reaching over 99% of the country, and commercial 5G service is available in all 63 provinces, with expansion ongoing . Major carriers include Viettel, VNPT, and Mobifone, with Viettel being the most extensive and reliable, even in rural areas . Mobile data plans are affordable, with basic packages starting around \$2 per month and unlimited plans around \$8-\$9 per month .

eSIMs and SIM Cards

For travelers or residents without fiber, eSIMs and local SIM cards are convenient options. Popular eSIM providers include Saily (\$3.99/1GB on Viettel), Holafly (unlimited from \$19), and Airalo for flexible plans . Local SIM cards can be purchased at airports, convenience stores, or carrier shops, offering fast setup and reliable coverage .

Pocket Wi-Fi

Portable Wi-Fi devices are another alternative, allowing multiple devices to connect via a mobile network. These are especially useful for temporary stays or when traveling between cities. They rely on the same 4G/5G networks and provide stable internet for work or streaming .

Satellite Internet

Vietnam has approved a Starlink pilot program, allowing SpaceX to provide satellite internet with a 600,000-subscriber limit and local gateway requirements . This option is ideal for remote or rural areas where mobile coverage may be weaker or for users needing high-speed international connectivity.

VPN Considerations

Due to government restrictions on certain platforms like Facebook and Instagram, using a VPN (e.g., NordVPN or Surfshark) is recommended to ensure unrestricted access to social media and news sites .

Practical Tips

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- o Check network coverage in your area before choosing a plan. Viettel generally offers the widest reach.
- o For temporary stays, eSIMs or pocket Wi-Fi are convenient and cost-effective.
- o For long-term residents, a local SIM with a monthly data plan provides reliable connectivity.
- o Consider a VPN to bypass content restrictions and maintain privacy.
- o In rural or remote areas, Starlink or 4G/5G mobile networks are the most viable alternatives to fiber . By combining these options, you can maintain fast, reliable internet access in Vietnam without relying on fiber optic connections.
