Shelf load capacity depends on material, thickness, span between supports, and mounting method. Distributed Load Formula: $\text{Max Load (kg)} = (\text{Material Strength} \times \text{Thickness}^3 \times \text{Width}) / (\text{Support Span}^2 \times \text{Safety Factor})$ Calculate shelf load capacity, deflection, and bracket spacing from material strength, dimensions, load, and sag limit for shelves. Enter any 4 values to calculate the 5th. Switch between design and check modes, then download tidy reports as needed. Choose units first; conversions run automatically. This uses the simply-supported beam formula for a uniformly distributed load.

Calculate the maximum weight a shelf can hold based on material, length, depth, and support spacing. Avoid overloaded shelves.
