

How to check fiber optic cables on a router

Fiber optic cables connect to your router via an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), and you can verify the connection by inspecting the ONT, router ports, and testing the fiber link.

Identify the Fiber Setup

Most home fiber connections do not plug directly into a standard router. Instead, the fiber line terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the optical signal into an electrical signal your router can use . To check if your router is connected to fiber:

- o Locate the ONT near where the fiber enters your home, often on a wall or in a closet.
- o Look for a fiber optic cable (usually thin, yellow, with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors) plugged into the ONT's optical port.
- o Check that an Ethernet cable runs from the ONT's LAN or Ethernet output port to the router's WAN or Internet port .

Verify Router and ONT Status

- o Power light on the ONT should be solid green.
- o PON or Optical light indicates the fiber link status: solid green/blue means active, flashing indicates connection attempts, and red or off signals a problem .
- o On the router, the WAN/Internet indicator should show connectivity, confirming the ONT-to-router link is functional .

Test the Fiber Cable

You can test the fiber cable itself using several methods:

- o Flashlight Test: Shine a focused LED flashlight into one end of the fiber. If light emerges from the other end, the fiber is intact .
- o Visual Fault Locator (VFL): A laser tool that highlights breaks or bends in the fiber.
- o Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR): Advanced testing that measures fiber length, losses, and faults.
- o Fluke or other fiber testers: Provide detailed diagnostics on signal quality and performance .

Additional Tips

- o Handle fiber connectors carefully; avoid touching the glass tip.
- o Ensure the ONT and router are powered in the correct sequence: ONT first, then router.

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If the PON light is red or off, contact your ISP, as this usually indicates a fiber line or signal issue. By following these steps, you can confirm whether your router is properly connected to a fiber optic network and ensure the fiber cable is functioning correctly.
