

# How to conceal the cover of the electrical distribution box

## Article Overview

You can conceal an electrical distribution box using decorative, easily removable covers like hinged artwork, mirrors, or shallow cabinets while maintaining safety and accessibility.

## Safety First

Before attempting to hide an electrical box, it is crucial to adhere to safety regulations. The National Electrical Code (NEC) requires a minimum working space in front of the panel: at least 36 inches deep, 30 inches wide (or the full width of the panel), and 6 feet 6 inches high. Any cover must be non-permanent and instantly removable without tools to allow emergency access or maintenance .

## Decorative Concealment Options

- o Hinged Artwork or Mirrors: Mount a lightweight frame or painting on butt hinges so it swings open like a door. Magnetic catches or small latches keep it flush against the wall but allow tool-less access .
- o Shallow Cabinets or Wall Panels: Build a custom cabinet or panel that fits around the box. Ensure it is lightweight and easily removable. Materials like wood or composite boards work well and can match your room decor .
- o Curtains or Fabric Panels: A simple curtain or fabric screen can hide the box while remaining easy to move aside for access .
- o Decorative Screens or Folding Panels: Lightweight folding screens can be placed in front of the box in open areas, providing a flexible and stylish solution .
- o Creative DIY Covers: Pegboards, bulletin boards, or chalkboards can disguise the box while adding functionality to the space .

## Considerations for Placement

- o Measure the width, height, and depth of the box to ensure full coverage without bulkiness .
- o Evaluate the surrounding wall area and materials (drywall, plaster, etc.) to select the most suitable concealment method .
- o Avoid placing heavy or rigid materials that could fall or obstruct access in an emergency .

## Outdoor or Garden Concealment

For exterior boxes, options include artificial boulders, tall plants, or decorative enclosures that blend with landscaping while remaining removable for maintenance .
