- o Grounding: Connect the grounding bar to a reliable earth electrode to prevent electrical hazards .
- o Testing: Perform visual inspection and use a multimeter to verify correct connections and absence of shorts before powering on .
- o Labeling: Clearly label each breaker for easy identification of circuits .

- o Follow local electrical codes and standards (IEC or regional equivalents in Central Asia).
- o Use UL/CE-certified components to ensure safety and reliability.
