

How to connect a fiber optic cable to a router with a faster connection

- o Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you use VoIP, gaming, or video conferencing to prioritize traffic .

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Step 6: Optimize Placement and Environment

- o Place the ONT and router near power outlets in a dry, ventilated area, away from extreme temperatures or moisture .
