

How to connect a router to a fiber optic cable box in the home

To connect a home router to a fiber optic cable, you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal into Ethernet, which then connects to your router's WAN port.

Required Equipment

- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP, it converts the fiber optic signal into an electrical signal your router can use .
- o Fiber optic cable: Usually single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- o Ethernet cable: Cat6 or higher is recommended for high-speed data transfer .

- o Power on the ONT: Plug in the power adapter and wait 2-5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize .
- o Connect the ONT to your router: Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN/Internet port .
- o Power on the router: Wait for the router's indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .
- o Configure the router: Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1), and enter ISP credentials if required. Update firmware for optimal performance and security .

Tips and Precautions

- o Place the ONT and router near electrical outlets and in a dry, ventilated area .
- o Avoid bending the fiber cable sharply to prevent damage .
- o Ensure all connections are secure and check the status lights on both the ONT and router to verify connectivity .
- o Run a speed test after setup to confirm the connection is performing as expected . Following these steps ensures a stable, high-speed fiber optic internet connection for your home network.
