

How to connect a yellow corrugated pigtail hose

Preview

Install the proper length connector to allow a 2" straight run of hose at each end fitting. Use pipe wrenches on both mating hexes to avoid twisting the hose. Keep hose free from all objects and debris. First, always refer to the relevant installation drawings. Then, follow each step strictly--no shortcuts allowed. Second, the pipe you're connecting the corrugated.
