A poor crimp will lead to mechanical distress resulting in optical performance degradation and operator's training and manufacturing engineering support. The purpose of this document is to provide guidance on SENKO's recommended method for electrical termination. This means either fitting a connector to its end, or connecting it directly to another fiber, known as splicing.
