

How to disconnect the end of a multimode fiber optic cable

To safely disconnect a multimode fiber optic cable, gently release the connector from the port while avoiding bending or touching the fiber tip.

Cap the Fiber Immediately place a protective dust cap on the disconnected fiber end to prevent contamination and physical damage. 6. Store Properly Coil the fiber loosely and store it in a clean, dry location. Avoid stacking heavy objects on the cable or leaving it in areas with high foot traffic.

- o Do not touch the glass tip of the fiber; oils from your fingers can degrade signal quality.
- o Label cables if multiple fibers are disconnected to ensure correct reconnection.
- o Use proper tools if the fiber is part of a preterminated assembly or patch panel to avoid damaging connectors or ports.
