

# How to ground a distribution box if it doesn't have a neutral wire

## Preview

The most common and simplest solution for an ungrounded circuit is to install a Ground-Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) device. A simple three-light receptacle tester is the quickest way to check a three-prong outlet, using a pattern of lights to indicate common wiring issues, including an open ground.
