

How to install a distribution box by drilling holes

- o Install breakers and bus bars: Mount the main circuit breaker, branch breakers, and neutral/ground bus bars inside the box ().
- o Connect conductors: Attach line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground, following color coding standards. Tighten connections securely to prevent loose contacts ().
- o Branch wiring: Run hot conductors from branch breakers to their respective outlets or circuits. Ensure proper segregation of neutral and ground paths ().
- o Cable management: Route wires neatly, secure with cable ties, and leave space for heat dissipation. Avoid tangling or contact with sharp edges ().

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Final Checks and Testing

- o Label each circuit clearly for future maintenance ().
- o Perform visual inspections and use a multimeter to verify connections and insulation resistance ().
- o Ensure all breakers and protective devices are correctly installed and functional ().
- o Once verified, reconnect the power supply and test each circuit for proper operation (). Following these steps ensures a safe, compliant, and reliable distribution box installation with drilled holes, minimizing the risk of electrical hazards and facilitating future maintenance ().
