

How to install and secure the wiring in the distribution box

Choosing and Installing the Distribution Box

Select a distribution box suitable for your environment (residential, commercial, or industrial) and ensure it meets the required IP/NEMA rating for protection against dust and moisture . Install the box in a dry, accessible, and ventilated area, typically around 1.5 meters above the ground for residential setups . Ensure the box is level, stable, and firmly fixed using expansion bolts or screws. For outdoor installations, use a waterproof enclosure and consider a rain cover to prevent water ingress .

Preparing and Arranging Wires

- o Wire stripping: Remove insulation to the correct length, avoiding excessive exposure that could cause short circuits or poor contact .
- o Wire color coding: Use standard colors (e.g., blue for neutral, yellow/green/red for phases) and select wire gauge according to circuit load (e.g., 2.5mm² for lighting and sockets, 4mm² for air conditioning), .
- o Neat arrangement: Route wires carefully inside the box, avoiding tangling or contact with sharp edges. Use zip ties to secure wires and maintain uniform spacing .
- o Heat dissipation: Leave space between wires and components to prevent overheating .

Connecting Wires to Terminals

- o Follow the principle: phase wire to phase terminal, neutral wire to neutral terminal, ground wire to ground terminal .
- o Use a wire stripper or crimping tool to ensure tight connections, or secure wires with screws for good conductivity .
- o Arrange circuit breakers from left to right, reserving space for future expansion .
- o Maintain consistent wiring direction: main circuit breaker connections on the left, outgoing circuits on the right .

Safety and Testing

- o Insulation resistance test: Use an insulation tester to verify that wires and the box meet insulation standards .
- o Circuit on/off test: Check each circuit with a multimeter to ensure no broken wires or short circuits .
- o Labeling: Clearly mark AC/DC circuits and voltage levels for easy identification and maintenance .



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o Protection devices: Install breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit to prevent overloads and short circuits .

- o Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC) and use UL/CE-certified components .
