

How to make a cold connector for optical fiber

Article Overview

A cold connector, or fast connector, allows optical fibers to be joined quickly using a mechanical splice without epoxy or fusion splicing.

Tools and Materials Needed

To make a cold connector, you will need the following tools and materials:

- o Fiber stripping tool to remove the protective coating without damaging the fiber
- o Fiber cleaver for precise, clean cuts
- o Optical power meter and visual fault locator for testing
- o Alcohol swabs for cleaning the fiber
- o Fast connectors or cold splice sleeves

Step-by-Step Procedure

1. **Fiber Stripping** Use a fiber stripping tool to carefully remove the outer jacket and coating of the fiber, exposing the bare glass. Ensure the fiber is stripped evenly to avoid damage . 2. **Fiber Cleaving** Cleave the fiber using a calibrated fiber cleaver to create a smooth, flat end. A precise cleave is critical for minimizing insertion loss in the splice . 3. **Mechanical Splicing** Insert the cleaved fiber ends into the cold connector or mechanical splice. Most cold connectors have a precision V-groove or alignment mechanism that holds the fibers in place and ensures proper core alignment . Push the fibers together until they are fully seated. 4. **Cleaning and Inspection** Before finalizing the connection, clean the fiber ends with alcohol swabs to remove dust or debris. Inspect the alignment visually or with a microscope if available . 5. **Testing the Connection** Use an optical power meter to measure light transmission and a visual fault locator to check for any visible faults. This ensures the connection has low loss and is functioning correctly .

Tips for Successful Cold Connections

- o Handle fibers carefully to avoid breakage or contamination .
- o Ensure the cleaver is properly calibrated for the fiber type (singlemode or multimode), .
- o Cold connectors are ideal for FTTH (Fiber to the Home) installations due to their speed and convenience .
- o Two common forms of cold connection are field quick linkers and fiber butt cold splices, both providing fast, reliable connections without fusion . By following these steps and using the proper tools, you can create a reliable, low-loss cold connector for optical fiber installations efficiently.
