

How to make the grounding wire for the distribution box

Article Overview

To properly ground a distribution box, use a copper wire of appropriate cross-section, connect it securely to the box and a grounding rod, and verify the grounding resistance meets safety standards.

Materials and Tools

- o Copper wire: Yellow-green insulated, cross-sectional area according to local standards (e.g., 6 mm² internationally, 10 AWG in the US) .
- o Grounding rod: Metal rod buried in the earth to provide a stable grounding point .
- o Fasteners: Screws, nuts, and washers to secure connections .
- o Tools: Screwdriver, wire stripper, voltmeter or grounding resistance tester, insulating gloves .

Steps to Make and Connect the Grounding Wire

- o Locate the grounding point: Open the distribution box and identify the PE (Protective Earth) bar or grounding plate .
- o Prepare the wire: Strip the insulation at both ends of the copper wire to expose enough conductor for a secure connection .
- o Connect to the box: Attach one end of the wire to a metal part of the distribution box or the PE bar using screws and washers to ensure firm contact .
- o Connect to the grounding rod: Lead the other end of the wire to the grounding rod buried in the earth. Ensure the rod is fully inserted and in good contact with soil .
- o Secure connections: Tighten all fasteners and ensure the wire is firmly fixed without looseness .
- o Test grounding resistance: Use a grounding resistance tester or voltmeter to measure the resistance. It should meet safety standards (typically
