

How to plug in the fiber optic cable to the switch

If the link does not establish, verify fiber type, transceiver compatibility, and that the cable is not damaged . 6. **Avoid Common Mistakes**

- o Do not plug fiber into a standard Ethernet port; it requires an SFP module or media converter .
- o Match single-mode fiber with single-mode SFPs and multi-mode fiber with multi-mode SFPs.
- o Keep fiber ends clean to prevent signal loss or errors. Following these steps ensures a stable and functional fiber connection between your switch and other network devices .
